Mobile App

Allows members to view their balances, transfer funds, locate nearby ATM's and Shared Branches and also do Remote Deposit Capture.

ACH Origination

External Transfers to and from your iamfcu account.

(Debit cards are equipped with EMV chip security for added protection)

Make an appointment with one of our Financial Service Representatives (FSR) and get the help that you need with the possibility of obtaining an Emergency Loan with no credit check! Inquire within for more information.

Dormant Account/Abandoned Property Avoid losing your money to the State

Remember, your account with the credit union is a lifetime membership. If you no longer work for 1199 or have retired, please keep your account active by making a small withdrawal or deposit at least twice a year to avoid a \$5 monthly dormancy fee.

Your account is considered inactive after 12 months. Below, please find a few options to transact on your account:

1. Visit a nearby SHARED BRANCH, Log on to our website at www.iamfedcu.org enter your zip code to locate a Shared Branch
2. Login to your online account at www.iamfedcu.org to initiate an external transfer from your financial institution to your credit union account. Please allow 2-3 business days to complete transfer
3. Mail a check or money order

After 3 years of inactivity we are required by New York State law to turn over your funds to them and 5 years for other states.

If your account is already dormant, please make a transaction by visiting a Shared Branch near you or mail a check to us, with 2 valid pieces of approved IDs, (e.g. U.S. Passport, State ID/Driver's License, Green Card, Work Authorization Card, Job ID). **Please make sure both pieces of IDs are not expired and that your name and signatures matches each other.**
